

Special Event Station WW1USA

The National World War I Museum and Memorial of the United States is located in Kansas City, Missouri. Opened to the public as the Liberty Memorial museum in 1926, it was designated in 2004 by the United States Congress as America's official museum dedicated to World War I.



My tour of the Museum and Memorial was very thought provoking. After watching several short documentaries with original film footage and exploring the vast array of exhibits, I realized how lucky I am to live in this country during this era and not in the 1920's.

The National WW1 Museum and Memorial has partnered with local amateur radio operators to host this special event station from 2014 through 2018. WW1USA is the Amateur Radio Voice of the Museum and Memorial.

More than 300 operators from the Kansas City area and visitors have participated in the operation of WW1USA. Recently your editor, K4CGA, had the opportunity to visit the museum and participate as a 20m SSB operator. What a great experience. Operations included CW, FT8 and SSB on multiple bands.

WW1USA hopes to continue their Special Event operations into the future if allowed to do so.

A World War II codebreaker has vowed to take the secrets of her work "to the end of my days".

Margaret Wilson, 95, trained as a wireless operator before being transferred to Bletchley Park in 1942, where she listened to German radio.

At the time, she did not realize the importance of the work - but even now she knows its significance she will not reveal all.

Despite pleas from researchers and family, Mrs. Wilson, from Shirebrook, said: "No one else has talked, so I will not."



Several of our club members have been participating in building portable RDF (Radio Direction Finder) units to participate in a "FOX" hunt. No, not real 4 legged foxes!

A fox hunt is an amateur radio activity where participants use RDF equipment and techniques to locate one or more radio transmitters hidden within a designated search area.

Using these techniques and equipment allows the amatuer radio operator to effectively locate malicious and non-malicious radio transmitters, receiver interference and lost vessels or aircraft.




