
For several years now, Dave – K4DMF has been educating our club with presentations that have helped our members understand the causes and basics behind some of our sever weather.

Just like the weather changes, so do Dave's presentations. They are always updated with the latest information. Don't miss out on this great opportunity at our April meeting.




