SCARS Annual AM Broadcast Band DX Contest!



UcxLog - Shareware Log and Contest Program!




UCXlog is a very unique shareware program with lots of features. It would be worth your while to check it out and see if it meets your needs. Free is good. Here are some features that might be of interest to you. - *Editor*

- Log book with unlimited number of QSOs.
- Comfortable CW and speech generation (output LPT/COM/WinKey/Soundcard).
- Digital modes by coupling with Fldigi, MMTTY engine and WSJT-X/JTDX, integral BPSK/QPSK.
- World map in Rectangular or Great Circle projection with gray-line, short and long path.
- Control of up to 5 transceivers: ICOM, Kenwood, Elecraft, many YAESU and Ten-Tec models and some others.
- DX cluster / band map via TNC/Telnets/WWW with many filters (DXCC and IOTA detection), takeover to log and TRX.
- Spectrum analysis and audio recorder (soundcard).
- DXpedition mode and QSO statistics.
- Flexible QSL print for cards and labels with optional background images.
- Safe database with extreme fast call sign search.
- Import/export: ADIF, ASCII, Cabrillo, STF, EDI, LOTW, eQSL, Clublog, RSGB-IOTA

This transceiver for under \$75 comes in kit form and would make a great project for those interested in DIY during the winter months. Beats blowing leaves or shoveling snow (really?).



WSJT-X fix to HAMLIB!



From Joe Taylor, K1JT: *Submitted by Lee WB4Q0J*

"An error crept into the latest Hamlib code and broke the WSJT-X rig-control features for certain Icom radios. We are therefore releasing WSJT-X Version 2.1.2, which replaces the Version 2.1.1 released yesterday.

If you had rig-control problems with v2.1.1 you should definitely upgrade to v2.1.2. Others might as well do so also, though you will likely see no differences compared to v2.1.1.

Ground Loop Eliminators for SDR's!



One simple solution to breaking a USB ground loop and reducing noise is to disconnect the often dirty +5 VDC power at the USB output of the host computer.

This project allows the USB power from the host computer to be replaced by an external low-noise power supply via the binding posts which may reduce noise for SDR's that aren't powered by a separate supply.

In the summer of 2012, a NASA spacecraft named Voyager 1 became the first humanmade object to enter interstellar space.


Voyager 1 was launched in 1977. By 1989 it had visited Jupiter and Saturn, and crossed the orbits of (but did not visit) Uranus, and Neptune.

As of 2015, it is over 12,161,300,000 miles away from Earth.

In 300 years it will reach the beginning of the **Oort Cloud**. The Oort Cloud is a collection of icy material where many comets come from. This material is likely the furthest stuff still orbiting around our sun.

In 30,000 years it will reach the end of the Oort Cloud. The Oort Cloud is huge!

40,000 years from now it will be closer to another star than to our own sun.




2019 ARRL November Sweepstakes!


