
What is POTA? POTA (Parks On The Air), is a 501(c)3 RadioSport program that encourages communications to and portable operations from state, provincial, nationally and internationally managed public lands. POTA has a large set of references and a short set of rules.

To get started

Creating an account is fast and easy. POTA stores no passwords, we authenticate against accounts you already have. Select the Dashboard/Login link at parksontheair.com info@parksontheair.com if you need assistance.

Activators


How do you activate a POTA reference? Make 10 QSOs on one UTC day while inside the boundaries of the park on any band your privileges allow including WARC bands. Utilize any simplex mode including satellite. No terrestrial repeaters allowed. POTA recommends operating in the General bands but has no specific calling frequencies. There is no specific exchange beyond call sign,



although the traditional RST is usually given along with QTH. If you prefer, you do not have to call CQ POTA or announce you are at a park.

Hunters

- Create an account at parksontheair.com
- Make the QSO & a post a fresh spot if warranted
- No log submission is necessary
- Check your dashboard for stats at parksontheair.com



SCARS 1st POTA Contest (continued)

Scoring

Your score will be a total of:

- 1. Number of Hunter contacts (verified on the POTA website) made with ANY POTA activator PLUS
- 2. Number of contacts made as a park activator multiplied by the number of parks activated

Example: Chuck has 42 contacts as a hunter in the months of October, and activates 2 parks with the required 10 contacts at each. Chuck will have $42 + (2 \times 10) = 62$ points. Scores are on the honor system ... this is just for fun, folks! We will have an online way of everyone putting in their scores.

BONUS AWARD

The SCARS toberfest award will go to the operator with the highest total POTA score plus SCARS AM Broadcast DX score!

Fall Is Here, Winter Is Coming!



Fall is a great time of year to perform regular maintenance on your outdoor antenna equipment. The temperatures are usually pleasant, humidity may be more comfortable, the scenery is beautiful and it is easier to talk someone into helping you.

Identifying and fixing potential problems will minimize the chance that your equipment might fail or perform poorly when needed the most, for

instance, a disaster or very inclement weather. If you are a contester or DX hunter, you don't want to be troubleshooting during a heavy rain or snow storm. The effort now is well worth it.

Here are a few tips and suggestions to get you started:

Check your foliage! Trim those branches. Remove those trees. Remember, we live in Georgia which it known for its trees, especially pine trees which have a habit of snapping in high winds. We are also subject to high winds caused by tornados and tropical storms.

Check your guy lines and antenna support ropes. Sometimes we get an unusual amount of rain in our area. That tends to soften the ground with may loosen guy anchors and tree roots. Certain materials used to support antennas may also stretch and cause your antenna to sway and cause stress on other hardware or feed lines.

Check your feedlines and connectors. Many feedlines and connectors are exposed directly to Sun, Heat and Moisture as well as mechanical stress from movement. Make sure your coax is not cracked, or dinged. Inspect your connectors for moisture, corrosion and physical integrity. Be sure your connections are properly sealed and protected.

Inspect ground connections: ground rods, radials, surge arresters. Insure they are clean and not damaged. Check the surge arrestors to make sure they are still within specifications.


Check towers and antenna mounts. Check for physical damage, corrosion and tightness of the hardware. Inspect your climbing hardware for safety issues. Remember, your antenna system is of no use if you're injured or become an SK.

Prepare now and you can stay warm and have fun later.
