




Since our social meetings have been temporarily cancelled, your chances of meeting and paying our treasurer in person are pretty slim.

For those that aren't familiar with podcasts, they are audio files, usually a series of episodes that you can download and play on your mobile device or computer. Apple and Android devices have podcast apps that let you subscribe and then automatically download the latest episodes to your device. There are probably tens of thousands of podcasts, but I want to highlight three that are focused on Amateur Radio that I really love.

Ham Radio Workbench

This Ham Radio podcast deep dives on making, DIY, electronics, and technical topics of interest to the amateur radio operator. The host, George KJ6VU, discusses current developments in ham radio while introducing listeners to a plethora of topics and skills such as test equipment, radio technology, Arduino, Raspberry Pi, and more.

George always has a great group with him, and his guests and topics are always fantastic.

QSO Today is a podcast about the international hobby of amateur radio also known as ham radio. Every week, Eric interviews "hams" to hear their ham radio story and what they are doing now. Many of the technologies that we enjoy today including television and radio, cell phones, computers, and the Internet were born out amateur radio hobbyists experimenting with electronics and radio in their basements and garages. Amateur radio was and still is the frontier where hams conducted electronic experiments in order to make that wireless contact around the World.

Pablo had an interesting aviation career where amateur radio weaved in and out of it since the late seventies. 


